Sub: Provision regarding payment of compensation to outsider human beings due to Electrocution by live wire.

It has been found that due to snapping of live electric wire, human beings come into its contact and are electrocuted causing death or injury. There is no such scheme in the Board for payment of compensation to outsiders on electrocution. In the absence of any compensation scheme, for the outsiders, the compensation is fixed either by the Trial Courts or District Administration, which varies. In order to have uniformity in the payment of compensations, the Board has formulated its own Compensation Scheme for the outsiders which is as follows: -

Nature of damage

1. a. For Fatal
b. For Non Fatal
i. Loss of two limbs or
two eyes or one limb
and one eye.
ii. Loss of one limb or one
eye.

Amount of Compensation
Rs. 20,000.00

Rs. 15,000.00

2. The decision as to whether the injuries are minor or major will be decided as per the Medical Certificate from the Chief Medical Officer cum Civil Surgeon of the district where the accident occurred.

These provisions will not apply in case of accident to personnel of Board's contractors or their sub-contractors.

3. The payment of compensation should be subject to findings of the Enquiry Committee consisting of the following officers, provided the victim was not at fault for the accident.

 General Manager/ General Manager cum Chief Engineer of the concerned Area where accident occurred : Chairman

2. Electrical Superintending Engineer of the concerned area

: Member

3. Director (Personnel)

: Member Secretary

4. Director of Accounts

: Member

The Committee will enquire into the accident and find out the facts of accident and suggest remedial measures to prevent such accidents in future. The Committee will also examine whether Board's employees are responsible for the accident. While considering the case of claimants, the Committee will examine the following documents:

I Investigation Report of concerned Assistant Electrical Executive Engineer of the Division

II. Police Panchnama.

III. Post-Mortem Report in case of fatal accident.

IV. Permanent Disability Certificate of Civil Surgeon in case of non-fatal accident.

V. Legal Heir Certificate in case of fatal accident.

VI. Electrical Inspector's Report and its compliance thereof.

In case there is delay in receipt of legal heir certificate, the compensation may be sanctioned but the payment will be released only on receipt of Legal Heir Certificate.

4. The Jharkhand State Electricity Board will not provide any employment to the wards/ dependents of the deceased on this count.
